Last academic year, the Department for Education introduced a new curriculum for Relationship Education, Relationships and Sex Education and Health Education. This is commonly shortened to RSE. It outlines the statutory requirement that schools are now required to deliver as part of their primary curriculum (September 2020).

When this change took place, I wrote to families to update you on these changes and to introduce a new scheme of work that we were introducing to support with the delivery of these sessions. The scheme is produced by Coram Life Education. It is called 'SCARF', which stands for 'Safety, Caring, Achievement, Resilience and Friendship.' This is an extremely thorough online scheme which sensitively covers the statutory requirements for RSE at an age appropriate level whilst also covering other PSHE areas of learning, such as caring for the environment and British Values. The scheme also prides itself in being able to support the Christian ethos within schools.

Previously, parents have been able to withdraw consent from these sessions in school. However, as these sessions are now statutory, this consent is no longer applicable. Therefore, we are asking all parents to confirm, for each child currently at school, that you are aware that Relationships and Sex Education is now compulsory.

This acknowledgement can be done online via Pay360 under the Sub-heading Exams & Lessons. If you cannot access Pay360 please send a letter to school, with the heading 'Relationship Education, Relationships, Sex Education & Health Education'. This letter must include your child/children's names, class/es and the wording 'I acknowledge Relationships and Sex Education lessons in school are now compulsory'. Print your name, sign and date this letter. Please confirm this either online via Pay360, or letter as soon as possible.

The school website contains details about the full scheme of work and there are some downloadable 'age expectation' documents that outline objectives being taught. The unit of work being referred to is taught in the final summer term and is called 'Growing and Changing'.
